Name of Dance

Music (Number of bars, repetitions, and type, e.g., 8x32R, 3x40S, 4x32H, etc.)

Number of couples (Add 'set' if the set size is the same as the number of couples and 'sq' for a square set) Source

Figures (Generally one column for each 8-bar pharse. Multiple figures in 8 bars can be separated by '|'. Use variations on the codes used by Napier, listed below.)
